INSULATED GLASS (IG) UNITS

LOW-E GLASS

Special coatings reflect infrared light, keeping heat inside in the winter and outside in the summer. They also reflect damaging ultraviolet light, which helps protect interior furnishings from fading.

GAS FILLS

Energy-efficient products have either argon or krypton gases between the panes. These odorless, colorless, non-toxic gases insulate better than regular air.

Two or three panes of glass with an air or gas-filled space in the middle, insulate much better than a single pane of glass.

This non-metal, structural foam spacer resists condensation, reduces energy costs, provides long-life durability and adds both comfort and value to your windows and patio doors.

Super Spacer is better able to ensure NFRC ENERGY STAR® certification by providing the best thermal conductivity, the lowest U-Factor among dual-seal systems and the best durability available in the industry. The all-foam formula blocks the heat escape path, improves sound absorption over traditional metal spacers and lasts up to nine times longer in durability tests than single-seal units. The all-foam formula reduces the effects of temperature changes, barometric pressure, wind load and glazing pressure, resulting in less seal failure and fewer stress cracks.


- A U-Factor** – Insulating value of the entire window system. Lower numbers reflect better insulating value.
- B Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC)** – Amount of heat from the sun passing through the glass. Lower numbers indicate glass is keeping heat from entering your home. SHGC is measured on a scale from 0 to 1.
- C Visible Transmittance** – Amount of visible light passing through the glass. Higher numbers indicate glass is allowing more light to enter your home. Visible transmittance is measured on a scale from 0 to 1.
- D Air Infiltration** – How much air is entering or escaping through the window. Lower numbers indicate air is kept from entering or escaping.
- E Condensation Resistance** – Amount of moisture it takes for glass to condensate when exposed to extreme interior and exterior temperature changes. Higher numbers indicate better resistance to condensation. Condensation resistance is scored on a scale of 0 to 100.





External Grids (Simulated Divided Lites) *Windows only

Grids are applied to the glass on both the interior and exterior of the window. If you decide to get painted windows, choosing SDL's as your grid choice allows the SDL's to be painted to match your exterior window color.







INTERNAL BLINDS

Internal blinds are a convenient option for blocking harsh sunlight and increasing privacy on windows and patio doors.

Constructed with sturdy aluminum and enclosed in tempered safety glass, the blinds are protected from weathering, damage, and dust, and they are not a hindrance to cleaning your glass.



WARRANTY HIGHLIGHTS



BASIC WINDOW OR PATIO DOOR UNIT - LIFETIME TRANSFERABLE

The rigid vinyl and factory-applied wood components of the window or patio door (not including factory installed jamb extensions), are warranted against chipping, cracking, peeling, pitting, blistering, warping or delamination for as long as you own and live in the Home in which the product was originally installed. This warranty is transferable to one subsequent purchaser.



HARDWARE - LIFETIME

ProVia® further warrants the moving parts, such as balances on double-hung windows and locking mechanisms in all units, for as long as the original purchaser owns and lives in the Home in which the product was originally installed, if those parts are not free from defects in material and workmanship under conditions of normal use and wear.



PATIO DOOR HANDLES - LIFETIME / 1 YEAR

ProVia further warrants all patio door handles with a Bright Brass, Satin Nickel or Aged Bronze finish against tarnishing for as long as you own and live in the Home in which the product was installed. Patio door handles with a painted finish, Flat Bronze, Modern Bronze or Antique Brass finish are warranted against flaking, checking, blistering or peeling for a period of (1) year from date of installation.




INSULATED GLASS UTILIZING SUPER SPACER® - LIFETIME

ProVia further warrants the insulated glass units utilizing Super Spacer in its vinyl windows or patio doors against defects resulting in material obstruction of vision as the result of film formation between the interior glass surfaces caused by failure of the air-tight seal, for as long as the original purchaser owns and lives in the Home in which the product was originally installed. Small spots, marks, lint, and scratches not exceeding applicable glass manufacturing specifications imposed by Federal Specification 1036-90 will not constitute defects under this warranty.



GLASS BREAKAGE - LIFETIME

ProVia further warrants the insulated glass units utilizing Super Spacer in its vinyl windows or patio doors against breakage as follows: (1) If the glass in a properly registered and warranty covered unit breaks as the result of a manufacturing defect; (2) In the event of an accident in the Home that is not covered by insurance or is of an amount that is within the insurance policy deductible, ProVia will replace the glass free of charge, for as long as the original purchaser owns and lives in the Home in which it was originally installed. Glass breakage is not covered for insulated glass units with internal blinds or insulated glass units in Garden Windows.



SCREENS - LIFETIME

Further, ProVia will replace under normal conditions of use, for as long as the original purchaser owns and lives in the Home in which the product was originally installed; for manufacturing defects, if the fiberglass, aluminum or stainless steel screening is not free from rotting, staining, or rusting. No warranty herein covers torn screen mesh caused by abnormal use, negligence, or other means not controlled by ProVia.



FLEXSCREENS - LIFETIME

Further, ProVia will replace under normal conditions of use, for as long as the original purchaser owns and lives in the Home in which the product was originally installed; for manufacturing defects, if the fiberglass screening is not free from rotting, staining, or rusting. No warranty herein covers torn screen mesh caused by abnormal use, negligence, or other means not controlled by ProVia.



PAINT/STAIN FINISH - 15 YEAR / 10 YEAR

ProVia® further warrants the factory-applied paint on vinyl window components against cracking, pitting, peeling, blistering or suffering from non-uniform fading discoloration (non-uniform fading discoloration resulting from unequal exposure of surfaces to the sun and elements is not covered by this warranty) and defects in material and workmanship for a period of fifteen (15) years from date of installation.

Internal blind units are warranted against seal failure and defects in material and workmanship for a period of ten (10) years from date of installation.



BAY, BOW & GARDEN WINDOWS - 10 YEAR

Bay and Bow windows (frames and roof kits) and Garden Windows (frames, sashes, hardware and insulated glass units) are warranted against defects in material and workmanship for a period of ten (10) years from date of installation. Garden windows are not available in the Aeris series.



TRANSFERABLE WARRANTY

The Warranty on the basic window or patio door unit is transferable by the original purchaser to one subsequent purchaser for purchaser's personal residence provided the warranty transfer is completed within thirty (30) days after the date of transfer of ownership. For products that are installed in a Coastal region the time periods stated in this warranty shall be limited as follows: Non stainless steel hardware mechanisms in Casement Window & Patio Door units - 5 year mechanical warranty; Aged Bronze, Bright Brass or Satin Nickel Patio Door Handles – 10 Year Finish. 


